


Colombia Which are our priorities?

In Colombia, water resources and forests are

priorities.

Colombia has annual water resources of approximately 2,265 Km³ and a caudal of 71.800 m³/s.

53% of the territory has forest natural cover.






Digital elevation model of Tota Lake Watershed






Percentage of forest area in Colombia between 2000 and 2012
