Policy Priority: Sustainable fisheries production

▶ Capture

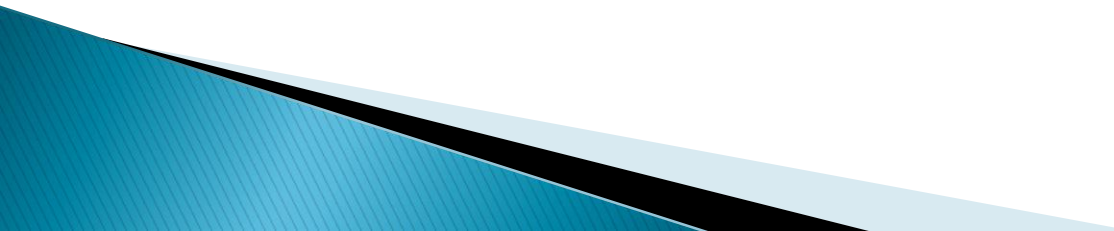
- Effective law enforcement (BFAR and LGU)– e.g. fishing gears; open access areas; establishment and maintenance of sanctuaries
 - Implement fisherfolk registration (FishR)
 - Mobilization of FARMC's
 - Stock enhancement of threatened/dwindling indigenous fish stocks
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Policy Priority: Sustainable fisheries production

▶ Aquaculture

- Review and updating of ZOMAP (LLDA)
- Regulation on stocking densities (LLDA, BFAR)
- Research on biology of indigenous species (SEAFDEC, BFAR)
- Implementation of Good Aquaculture Practice (GAP) or FAO 214
- Determine carrying capacity for aquaculture (compatible with capture fisheries)

Policy Priority: Improve biodiversity of the lake

- ▶ Conduct fisheries stock assessment
 - ▶ Containment of existing IAS; prevent further introduction of new IAS (implement FAO 221)
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For both priorities

- ▶ Strengthen institutional linkages
 - ▶ Sharing of data and resources
 - ▶ IEC, capacity building and value formation for fisherfolk
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
