Mangrove Restoration in Cozumel

- Assessed the economic value of ecosystem services provided by Marine Protected Areas in Cozumel
- Focused on tourism revenue and flood protection
- Mexican Park Service invested 20M Pesos in mangrove restoration in Cozumel



Creation of the Yaguas National Park in Peru

- Valued and included ecosystem services in a benefit cost analysis to inform the decision on Yaguas
- Showed that benefits are greater than the costs by about US\$7.7 million
- Worked with Ministries and Park agencies to create this National Park



Sustainable Cattle Ranching in Colombia

- CSF calculated ecosystem service production under different management systems
- Designed recommendations for multiple stakeholders to co-fund investments needed to secure ecosystem services
- Worked with local institutions and partners (UNDP-led) to get buy-in from national and regional governments
