RESULTS

- All countries are interested in NCA
- 11 countries have attempted 15 types of NCA
- Some countries began experimenting with NCA in the 1980's and early 1990's
- Countries differ in their priorities, but the hurdles and the opportunities are similar across the GDSA



HURDLES

- Lack of data (non-existent, inadequate quality, irregularly collected)
- Lack of long-term funding
- Lack of capacity and resources (technical and non-technical)
- Limited communication between government agencies and with decision-makers; lack of skills on how to communicate with decision-makers





HURDLES

- Difficulty repeating accounts once pilots have been created
- Need to share lessons between countries
- Lack of clear steps for how to actually use the information in accounts once they have been created





OPPORTUNITIES

- All countries need:
 - Data/data management
 - Long-term funding/resource mobilization
 - Capacity building
 - Assistance in communicating to decision-makers
- · At the regional level, there is a need for:



- Lessons sharing
 - Communicating and support among countries

WHAT WE HAVE HEARD


- WHAT: The Community of Practice would be a 'regional collaboration and action platform' for NCA. "Talk shop" + "Action Platform"
- HOW: Online presence + in-person annual meetings.
 NCA Lead that is linked to in-country steering committees or informal communities of practice.
- WHO: Technical accounts producers and technical account users. Support for the 'telephone directory' idea. Not limited just to GDSA countries.
- ACTIVITIES: annual meeting, learning exchange, targeted R&D grants. Thematic sub-groups that focus on specific types of accounts. Bringing together partners.





WHAT WE HAVE HEARD

- The COP is not going to:
 - Duplicate the targets/outcomes that countries already have
 - Move into the accounting space in the sense of doing accounts themselves.
