- 6. The Steering committee has the right to establish one or more technical working groups to assist in its overseeing implementation of the project.
- 7. The Steering committee will be responsible for nominating members and the Terms of Reference for any Technical Working Group that is created.
- 8. The members of the steering committee will meet quarterly.
